DALLAS -- William J. Stenstrom, assistant professor of ophthalmic illustration, The University of Texas (Southwestern) Medical School at Dallas, will conduct a three-day workshop on the procedures and techniques of eye illustration Nov. 26-28 in Toronto, Canada.

Mr. Stenstrom also will deliver the Lloyd Morgan Lecture at the annual alumni meeting of the Hospital for Sick Children at Toronto. Medical art students from the University of Toronto Medical School will attend the workshops. Subject for the Morgan Lecture will be "Ophthalmic Illustration: It's Heritage and Future."

The Dallas professor will deliver the same lecture on Dec. 1 before medical art students at Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine, Baltimore, Md.

A recognized authority in the field of ophthalmic illustration, Mr. Stenstrom was chief of the Medical Illustration Laboratory, U.S. Veterans Administration Hospital, Seattle, and was an illustrator with the Retina Foundation, Boston, before joining the Departments of Medical Art and Ophthalmology at UTSMS.
