transfusion specialist.

DALLAS--An expert on procedures of ordering and matching blood for transfusion during surgery will deliver the Second Annual George Peacock Memorial Lecture at The University of Texas Health Science Center here Friday, May 27.

Dr. John Bernard Henry, director of clinical pathology at the State University of New York Upstate Medical Center, will speak on "Expected Blood Use in Elective Surgery."

Dr. Henry is past president of the American Association of Blood Banks and is on the boards of the American Society of Clinical Pathologists and the American Board of Pathology. He is dean of the College of Health Related Professions at SUNY.

The annual lectureship is a memorial for an Arlington pathologist who was a former resident at Southwestern Medical School.
