*****Doctors to learn latest in burn care.

DALLAS--"Critical Issues in Burn Care," a seminar for physicians, will be held October 13 and 14 at The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas. Sponsor is the Regional Burn Program, headed by Dr. Charles R. Baxter, professor of surgery at the center and director of the Parkland Memorial Hospital burn unit.

Among the topics to be covered during the two-day program are pathophysiology of burns, resuscitation and organ systems management, inhalation injuries, metabolism and nutrition, wound management and sepsis, biologic dressings, burn-wound excision, physiotherapy and rehabilitation and out-patient and emergency care.

Besides Baxter, members of the teaching team include Drs. Phala A. Helm, chairman of the Department of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation; John L. Hunt, assistant professor of surgery; Ronald Sato, assistant professor of surgery; and Albert Suarez, surgery fellow. Mary Gordon, R.N., M.S., is program director of the Regional Burn Program.
