****Simmons takes part in groundbreaking for new cancer center

DALLAS -- Dallas businessman Harold Simmons takes time out today (Tuesday) from his quest for control of Lockheed...the defense and aerospace giant...to help break ground for a new research tower at UT Southwestern Medical Center. Named in honor of Simmons' parents...it will house a comprehensive cancer center. Both were made possible by Simmons' 41-million-dollar gift to UT Southwestern in December 1988...the largest gift in the history of Texas higher education. It is the first of six new research buildings planned for a 30-acre site one-half mile from UT Southwestern's main campus in northwest Dallas. The building is slated for completion in February 1993.
