**Gifford-Hill Visiting Professor to present "state of the art" on non-Hodgkins lymphoma Feb. 24.

DALLAS--Noted cancer specialist Dr. John E. Ultmann of University of Chicago will be the 1983 Gifford-Hill Visiting Professor at The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas Feb. 21-25. Ultmann will present the major Gifford-Hill lecture "Non-Hodgkins Lymphoma Status 1983 -- Problems to Be Resolved" at Internal Medicine Grand Rounds Feb. 24 at 11 a.m. in the Richardson Lecture Hall (Room D1.502).

Ultmann is director of the University of Chicago Cancer Research Center and associate dean for research programs and professor of Medicine at The University of Chicago, School of Medicine.

The author or co-author of more than 300 scientific articles primarily on cancer, Ultmann has served on numerous advisory committees and editorial boards. He currently serves as consulting editor for <u>Leukemia Abstracts</u> and <u>The American Journal of Medicine</u>, consultant for <u>Cancer Nursing</u> and editorial board member for <u>Oncology Directory Newsletter</u> on Cancer.

A 1952 graduate of Columbia University College of Physicians and Surgeons, Ultmann did his internship in medicine at New York Hospital, Cornell Medical Center. He served as resident in medicine and in hematology and National Cancer Institute trainee at the same hospital. He worked as American Cancer Society fellow in hematology at College of Physicians and Surgeons, Francis Delafield Hospital and joined the faculty of CPS (Columbia University) in 1956. From there he went to the University of Chicago in 1968.

The Gifford-Hill Visiting Professorship, which brings a distinguished medical scholar to the campus as visiting professor for one week each year, is made possible by a grant to the medical school's Department of Internal Medicine by the Gifford-Hill companies. The visiting professor takes part in hospital ward rounds, seminars and conferences with medical students, staff and faculty at the health science center.
