Dr. Ralph W. Coltharp, Clinical Assistant Professor of Neuropsychiatry at Southwestern Medical School of the University of Texas, will attend the meetings of the International Council for Exceptional Children in Omaha, Nebraska, on May 1-3, 1952. Doctor Coltharp will serve as Consultant to the section on "The Child in Conflict with the Law."
