UT SOUTHWESTERN FACULTY RECEIVE HONORS

DALLAS – April 11, 2001 – Faculty members from UT Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas recently were recognized for outstanding achievements in their fields.

Maryann Faucher, a faculty associate of obstetrics and gynecology at UT Southwestern, has been appointed to the advisory panel for Cardiovascular Health for Women, a nationwide project to improve the knowledge of both nurses and lay people about women's health.

Her role on the national advisory panel will include developing programs and resources to help nurses and women learn more about heart disease and risk-reduction strategies.

Dr. Robin Jarrett, professor of psychiatry at UT Southwestern, recently was selected as a training scholar by the Fourjay Foundation for her continuing work in the field of cognitive therapy. The foundation presents training scholarships at the Beck Institute for Cognitive Therapy and Research to outstanding scholars and researchers.
