UT SOUTHWESTERN HOME OF DALLAS' "BEST DOCTORS IN AMERICA"

DALLAS — March 11, 1994 — The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas is home to some of the best doctors in the nation.

Fifty-eight of the 86 Dallas physicians recognized in the 1994 edition of "The Best Doctors in America" are regular faculty members at UT Southwestern and another 23 serve on the volunteer clinical faculty of the medical center.

The book's listings are based on a nationwide poll of doctors, who were asked to rate the clinical abilities of their peers by answering the question: "If a friend or loved one came to you with a medical problem in your field of expertise, and for some reason you could not handle the case, to whom would you send them?"

"What makes our survey of doctors so credible is that we have the evaluating done by other doctors," said one of the book's authors. "Someone who practices the same kind of medicine is uniquely well-suited to assess another doctor's competence."

The book lists 7,200 doctors nationwide, slightly more than 2 percent of the nation's practicing physicians. It covers 350 medical specialty areas from allergies to oncology. The book's senior editors are Pulitzer Prize winners Steven Naifeh and Gregory W. Smith. The book is published by Woodward/White Inc. and can be ordered directly from the publisher or special-ordered through bookstores.

Dr. Kern Wildenthal, UT Southwestern president, said, "We are pleased and delighted that so many of our faculty members were recognized among the best doctors in America. We recognize that it takes outstanding specialists to train the next generation of physicians. Our faculty members include some of the most distinguished medical practitioners in the world."
