DALLAS--Dr. Solomon Berson, a specialist in diabetes and endocrinology, will be the Winans Visiting Professor of Internal Medicine at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School April 25-30, 1971.

Dr. Berson, professor and chairman of the Department of Medicine, Mount Sinai School of Medicine, New York, is lecturer and recipient of the Banting Medal from the American Diabetes Association, a Harvey lecturer and winner of the Van Slyke Award and medal of the American Association of Clinical Chemists.

In addition to giving a formal lecture, Dr. Berson will consult with students and staff at UTSMS. The lectureship is made possible through gifts maintained by Southwestern Medical Foundation in honor of the late Dr. Henry M. Winans, a longtime member of the UTSMS faculty.

The visitor has served on editorial boards of journals and is a consultant to various health agencies in his field. He is the author of more than 180 scientific papers.
