\*\*\*Powell receives Stembridge Award.

DALLAS--Ted Powell, son of Mrs. Pat Powell of Ransom Canyon, received the \$1,000 Stembridge Award in Pathology at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School at Dallas May 18. At the 11th annual award presentation, Dr. Edwin Eigenbrodt, professor of Pathology, said the award goes each year to the senior medical student who has shown the most excellence of performance in pathology in the sophomore year and continuing interest during the last two years of school.

The award is given in honor of Dr. Vernie Stembridge, chairman of Pathology, by a group of his peers and former residents and students.

Powell will receive his M.D. degree from Southwestern Medical School in graduation ceremonies June 2. He is one of 196 who will graduate from Southwestern, a component of The UT Health Science Center at Dallas, this year.

The graduate will do his pathology residency at Parkland Memorial Hospital in Dallas. He plans to go into private practice.

A graduate of Texas Tech University in 1976, Powell attended medical technology school for one year and worked as a technologist for two years at St. Paul Hospital in Dallas before entering private practice.

Powell's wife Laura works as a private scrub nurse for a Dallas heart surgeon. The couple has one child, Michaela, who is two months old.
