\*\*\*\*\*\*UT Southwestern graduate wins Fulbright award.

DALLAS--Stephen A. Schendel, D.D.S., a recent graduate of The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School at Dallas oral surgery program, has been awarded a Fulbright fellowship for the 1979-80 academic year. He is one of approximately 350 nationwide who have been selected for Fulbright awards this year.

The grants are intended to increase mutual understanding between the people of the United States and other countries through the exchange of persons, knowledge and skills. Dr. Schendel will travel to the Centre Hospitalier Regional in Nantes, France, where he will conduct research and lecture on maxillofacial surgery. His grant provides for travel expenses plus a stipend.

Schendel's fellowship is "a real plum," says Dr. Adolph Giesecke, Jr., vice-chairman of anesthesiology and Fulbright faculty adviser at UT Southwestern. "I congradulate Dr. Schendel--it's quite an honor and I'm sure he will enjoy his year in France."

Dr. Schendel is a 1973 graduate of the University of Minnesota School of Dentistry and the winner of the 1978 Albert Carlotti Award for Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. He is currently conducting a national study on mandibular surgery for the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons.
