*****Southwestern scientists discuss
sleep on Sunday Night KLIF program.

DALLAS--Three scientists from The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School will discuss the latest research on sleep from 8 p.m. to 10 p.m. Sunday on Radio Station KLIF.

Dr. Kenneth Altshuler, professor and chairman of the Department of Psychiatry at Southwestern, along with Drs. Jorge Farber and John Herman, will be guests of Tim Jernigan on the station's "On The Line" public service program.

The discussants will cover areas of sleep disorder and dysfunction, sleep deprivation and various aspects of dreams. The program is open for telephone call-ins.

Dr. Altshuler has conducted extensive research in genetics, geriatrics, early total deafness, psychoanalysis, as well as sleep and dreams. Formerly professor of clinical psychiatry and director of Psychiatric Medical Education at Columbia University's College of Physicians and Surgeons in New York, Dr. Altshuler is author of some 80 articles and books.
