**Expert on Meniere's disease presents seminar at UTHSCD.

DALLAS--A nationally recognized expert on ear disease will present a continuing education seminar for physicians as visiting professor at The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas Oct. 29 from 8 a.m. till 5 p.m. in Room D1.200.

Dr. Michael M. Paparella, professor and chairman of the Department of Otolaryngology at the University of Minnesota, Minneapolis, will present a lecture on Meniere's disease at 8:40 a.m. followed by a case presentation and panel discussion.
