**Neaves receives award for male diseases

DALLAS--Dr. William Neaves, dean of the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences and professor of Cell Biology at The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas, has been selected as "The Young Andrologist" for 1983 by the American Society of Andrology. (Andrology is the scientific study of the masculine constitution and of the diseases of the male sex.) Neaves is internationally recognized as an outstanding researcher in the field of testicular function.

Richard J. Serins, M.D., president of the society, said that the cell biologist's "contributions to the biology of reproduction have been outstanding and are surely worthy of recognition at this time."

The presentation will be made at an awards ceremony during the American Society of Andrology's annual meeting in Philadelphia March 24.
