DALLAS--Research grants totaling more than \$300,000 have recently been awarded The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School, Sen. Lloyd Bentsen's office has informed school officials.

Dr. Jonathan Uhr, new chairman of the school's Department of Microbiology, received the largest grant--one for \$178,775 for an investigation of the biosynthesis of immunoglobulin. The grant was made by the National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases.

The National Cancer Institute has awarded Dr. Donald E. Carlson \$36,761 for the pre-clinical study of negative pions.

Dr. P. William Curreri is the recipient of a \$26,996 grant from the National Institute of General Medical Sciences for the study of metabolism and nutrition in burns and trauma.

The National Science Foundation has given Dr. Robert Dowben \$63,100 for a study of membrane proteins.
