**\$100,000 given by Lamar and Jeanette Norsworthy and Holly Corp.  
to support *Innovations in Medicine* at UT Southwestern**

DALLAS – March 14, 2006 – Lamar and Jeanette Norsworthy have donated \$50,000 and Mr. Norsworthy's company, Holly Corp., has contributed a similar sum to Southwestern Medical Foundation to support clinical and research programs at UT Southwestern Medical Center.

The donation is part of the medical center's \$500 million *Innovations in Medicine* campaign, for which Mr. Norsworthy serves as a member of the Leadership Council.

"UT Southwestern will be able to accelerate a number of top-priority initiatives because of this generous gift from the Norsworthys and Holly Corp.," said Dr. Kern Wildenthal, president of UT Southwestern. "Lamar and Jeanette have been closely involved with our institution, and this major vote of confidence in our effort is extremely gratifying and appreciated."

Dallas-based Holly refines and markets high-value light products such as gasoline, diesel fuel and jet fuel. Through its subsidiaries, the company operates major refineries in New Mexico, Utah and Montana. Holly also owns a large interest in Holly Energy Partners, L.P., which through subsidiaries runs petroleum product pipelines in Texas, New Mexico and Oklahoma and refined product terminals in several Southwest and Rocky Mountain states. In addition to refining, Holly conducts a small oil and gas exploration and production program.

Mr. Norsworthy joined Holly in 1967 and was elected to the company's board of directors in May 2001. He also served as Holly's chief executive officer from 1971 until January 2006.

He serves on the UT Southwestern Health System Board of Visitors, and on the Board of Visitors of UT M.D. Anderson Cancer Center. He also is a member of the board of advisors of the Maguire Energy Institute at Southern Methodist University's Cox School of Business and the boards of Holly Logistics Services and Cooper Cameron Corp.

"Lamar and Jeanette have been great supporters of the medical center and the foundation for many years, and we're very grateful for their generosity and commitment to the *Innovations in Medicine* campaign," said W. Plack Carr Jr., Southwestern Medical Foundation president.
