DALLAS--Dr. Roy Heyne and social worker Cheryl Phillips will open a series of programs on International Year of the Child, 1979, Wednesday noon at the UT Health Science Center.

Heyne, an assistant professor of pediatrics, and Phillips, who is employed by Dallas County Mental Health and Mental Retardation operate a cooperative child-abuse and neglect program through the school, Children's Medical Center and MHMR. The program will be held in Richardson Lecture Hall, D1.502. Sponsoring organization is Women's Action Group.

A program on incest is planned for February 28. Speaker will be Carla Dowben, J.D. Dr. Dowben is a legal-medical expert.

"Better Safe Than Sorry," a film which features children talking to other children, is scheduled for March 14. This film on children's safety is presented in cooperation with Dallas Working Against Rape. Sue James, director, DWAR, will be present to answer questions. Also, Elizabeth Heyne, will give tips on child-oriented equipment, such as safety belts.

Jack Wilmore, Ph.D., will be on campus March 28 to discuss''Female Athletes--Myth and Reality." Dr. Wilmore is president of the American College of Sports Medicine.

Special problems of working parents will be March 28's topic.

Nutrition for children will be discussed by Dr. Betty Ruth Caruth, Children's Medical Center, April 11.
