***Twelve researchers at UTHSCD are listed among "most-cited" scientists.

DALLAS--A dozen researchers at The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas have been mentioned in an article in "Current Comments." The article lists the 1,000 most-cited scientists for work published from 1965 till 1978.

"In the vast majority of cases, appearance on this list is an <u>indicator</u> that the person involved is of Nobel class," wrote Eugene Garfield of the Institute for Scientific Information.

The average number of citations among the authors was 3,811--more than 270 citations per year. The average author on the list published 121 papers over the 14-year period, appearing as the first author on about one-fourth of these publications.

The Dallas faculty members included Drs. Michael Brown (biochemistry), John Dietschy (gastroenterology), Ron Estabrook (biochemistry), Alfred Gilman (pharmacology), Joseph Goldstein (genetics), Samuel McCann (endocrinology), John Porter (physiology), Donald Seldin (physiology), Jonathan Uhr (immunology), Roger Unger (endocrinology), Jean Wilson (endocrinology) and Morris Ziff (immunology).
