DALLAS--Dr. Steven P. Pakes has joined The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School at Dallas as associate professor of Comparative Medicine and director of the Animal Resources Center.

Actively involved in comparative pathology research, Dr. Pakes was recently elected president-elect of the American College of Laboratory Animal Medicine at the group's annual meeting in August. Laboratory Animal Medicine is a specialty of veterinary medicine and deals with the diagnosis, treatment, and prevention of disease in animals used as subjects in biomedical activities.

Dr. Pakes received his B.S., D.V.M., M.S. and Ph.D. degrees from Ohio State University where he was a member of the graduate faculty and director of the postdoctoral program in laboratory animal medicine. He also served as director of the laboratory animal facility at Children's Hospital in Columbus.
