\*\*\*\*\*Noted biochemist Dr. Ernest Campaigne to be Robert A. Welch Foundation Lecturer at UT Health Science Center.

DALLAS--Dr. Ernest Campaigne, professor of chemistry at Indiana University, will visit The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas Feb. 14 as the Robert A. Welch Foundation lecturer for 1977.

Dr. Campaigne, a widely-known biochemist, will speak on "Bioisosteres of the Indole Messengers" at 4 p.m. in the Richardson Lecture Hall, D1.502, on the UT Health Science Center campus.

Dr. Campaigne's research interests have centered on the chemistry of heterocyclic sulfur compounds and the synthesis of biologically active molecules and have resulted in the development of several clinically useful drugs.

He is the author of more than 225 research articles and has been on the editorial boards of the Journal of Medicinal Chemistry, The Journal of Heterocyclic Chemistry, and The Quarterly Reports on Sulfur Chemistry.

He was a Visiting Scientist, 1962-1965, to the American Chemical Society and has served the Division of Medicinal Chemistry in a number of capacities, including that of chairman in 1968.

The lecture is one of a series that will be given in Texas colleges and universities through grants from the Houston-based Robert A. Welch Foundation.
