DALLAS--Nobel Laureate Christian de Duve, M.D., is the fourth annual Chilton Lecturer at The University of Texas Health Science Center. Dr. de Duve will lecture at 4 p.m. Tuesday, January 29, in the health science center's Zale Lecture Hall, Dl.600, on the topic "Lysosomes in Medicine."

Dr. de Duve is professor of biochemistry at Rockefeller University in New York and is also director of the International Institute of Cellular and Molecular Pathology at the Catholic University in Louvain, Belgium.

The Chilton Lectureship was established by the Chilton Foundation in honor of the late A.L. Chilton, who was interested in obesity and lipids. Each year the lectureship is administered by the Department of Biochemistry at the center. The names and signatures of each lecturer are affixed to a memorial plaque.
