DALLAS--The School of Allied Health Professions of The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School will hold its first commencement exercises Sunday (Aug. 22), conferring 38 degrees and certificates on candidates in four specialized health service fields.

Ceremonies will be held at 2 p.m. Sunday in the Weiss Educational Building Auditorium, 209 Oakenwald, at Methodist Hospital of Dallas.

Commencement addresses will be given by Col. Jerold L. Wheaton, commander of the School of Health Care Sciences at Sheppard Air Force Base, and by Dr. John W. Schermerhorn, dean of the School of Allied Health Professions.

This is the initial commencement for the health education institution which opened its doors last September with 57 students enrolled in four programs. Authorized by The University of Texas System Board of Regents to help relieve shortages of medical professionals, the institution now has around 50 full and part time faculty.

Additional programs are in planning stages.
