Booths will feature nutrition, coronary heart disease testing, physical assessment of health by computer, demonstrations on toxic dangers, danger signs of cancer, hearing and vision as well as glaucoma tests, behavior problems, cholesterol, blood pressure, body fat and glucose testing, posture screening, alcohol and drug screening, dangers and effects of the sun, mental health, depressive and manic-depressive diseases and organ donation.
