FORENSIC PATHOLOGY PROFESSOR WINS DISTINGUISHED EDUCATOR AWARD

DALLAS--Dr. Charles S. Petty has been named Distinguished Pathology Educator of 1992 by the American Society of Clinical Pathologists. Petty is professor of forensic science and pathology at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas and associate medical director of UT Southwestern's Transplant Services Center. He retired in 1991 as chief medical examiner of Dallas County.

One of the professional society's highest honors, the annual award pays homage to one whose career in pathology and laboratory medicine embraces education, research and administration as well as service to organized pathology. The award was established in honor of Dr. H.P. Smith, a pioneer of modern pathology.

The award will be presented at the American Society of Clinical Pathologists' annual meeting in Las Vegas in October.
