****Dr. Carol Cassell, author of Swept Away to speak at UTHSCD Family Planning Seminar

DALLAS--Dr. Carol Cassell, author of <u>Swept Away</u>: <u>Why Women Fear Their Own Sexuality</u>, will speak at a seminar for family planning professionals on Wednesday, April 17, at 10:00 a.m. in room E6.200 of The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas.

Cassell is president of the American Association of Sex Educators, Counselors and Therapists and a leader in the field of sexuality education.

In her work she has found that, in spite of the "sexual revolution," women continue to resort to a strategy she identifies as "Swept Away." Cassell defines this as a coping mechanism that allows women to be sexual while blaming responsibility for their actions on "temporary insanity," "being swept off their feet" or "blinded by love." Women who deny the true nature of their relationships set themselves up for disappointment and, possibly, for "passive" pregnancies.
