BOONE AND NELDA PICKENS DONATE \$1 MILLION TO SUPPORT CARDIOLOGY PROGRAMS AT UT SOUTHWESTERN

DALLAS – April 5, 2001 – Philanthropists Boone and Nelda Pickens have contributed \$1 million to support cardiology research at UT Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas.

A native of Holdenville, Okla., Mr. Pickens moved to Dallas in 1989. He founded Mesa Petroleum Corp., one of the leading oil and gas exploration and production firms in the nation, in 1951 in Amarillo. He graduated from Oklahoma State University with a bachelor's degree in geology. He is also chief executive officer of BP Capital, chairman and CEO of Pickens Fuel Corp., and president and CEO of Mesa Water Inc.

A strong supporter of physical fitness and research in the area of cardiology, Mr. Pickens provided his employees with a major fitness facility at Mesa's headquarters in 1979.

"We are honored by their gift," said Dr. Kern Wildenthal, president of UT Southwestern.

"Their contribution will help to expand our research in the area of heart disease."
