UT SOUTHWESTERN PROFESSORS HONORED

DALLAS — September 29, 1995 — **Dr. Paul C. Peters**, professor emeritus of urology and surgery at UT Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas, has been named to receive the Valentine Medal.

Awarded annually by the New York Academy of Medicine's urology section, the medal recognizes a urologist who has contributed significantly to the field.

The award was endowed by the late Dr. Ferdinand Valentine, a New York urologist who helped found the American Urological Association. It will be presented to Peters at the academy's annual meeting in April, where Peters is scheduled to address the urology section.

Peters, former chairman of urology at UT Southwestern, retired Aug. 31.

DALLAS — September 29, 1995 — **Dr. Robert Star**, associate professor of internal medicine at UT Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas, has been selected as the 1995 recipient of a Young Investigator Award given jointly by the American Society of Nephrology and the American Heart Association.

The award recognizes Star's laboratory research on a natural hormone that is thought to relieve pain and reduce fever. Star will present his findings at a conference this fall.
