DALLAS--We would like to add several more important statistics to the Oct. 23 news release on kidney stone classification and selective therapy work by The University of Texas Health Science Center researcher Dr. C.Y. Pak.

Pak's study involves careful diagnosis and selective therapy tailored to the various causes of kidney stone formation. He has been able to achieve prevention of stone formation in 70 to 91 percent of patients and reduced stone formation in 88 to 100 percent of patients.
