DALLAS--Founder and editor of <u>Medical Self-Care</u>, Tom Ferguson, M.D., will speak on campus at The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas on Jan. 11 from noon until 1 p.m. in room D1.700 sponsored by the American Medical Students Association.

Ferguson, medical editor of <u>The Whole Earth Catalog/Co-Evolution Quarterly</u> and regular columnist for the <u>Mother Earth News</u>, recently published <u>Medical Self-Care</u>: <u>Access to Health Tools</u>. He is a graduate of San Francisco State University and the Yale University School of Medicine.

A visiting lecturer at medical schools throughout the country and guest on many television shows including 60 Minutes and the Today Show, Ferguson received the 1980 Educational Press Association Distinguished Achievement Award for his writings on teaching self-care to children and the 1980 Lifetime Extension Award for reporting on self-help in the medical and health fields.
