DALLAS--Dr. David D. Daly, Scottish Rite Professor of Neurology at The University of Texas (Southwestern) Medical School has been picked to lead an international commission to coordinate studies and evaluations of anticonvulsant drugs.

The commission on the pharmacology of anticonvulsant drugs was established by the International Federation of Epilepsy Societies meeting recently in Helsinore, Denmark. Chairman Daly said the commission would meet at least two times a year to review the work going on throughout the world.

Although there are some well-established anticonvulsants, Dr. Daly said there is a need for new drugs in the field.
