DALLAS--Dr. Konrad Bloch, 1964 recipient of the Nobel Prize in physiology and medicine, is the second annual Chilton Lecturer at The University of Texas Health Science Center. Dr. Bloch's lecture at 4:00 p.m. Wednesday in the Zale Lecture Hall, Dl.600 is titled "Sterols and Membranes."

Dr. Bloch, a professor at Harvard University, received the Nobel Prize for his work in cholesterol synthesis.

The Chilton Lectureship was established by the Chilton Foundation in honor of the late A. L. Chilton who was interested in obesity and lipids. Each year the lectureship is administered by the Department of Biochemistry at the center. The names and signatures of each lecturer are affixed to a memorial plaque.
