DALLAS--Health Check, a free public event where people can have their health checked out while learning what's available in Dallas' medical community, will take place Feb. 24 and 25 at Valley View Center. Booths staffed with medical personnel will provide more than \$175 worth of free checkups per person.

Health Check is sponsored by the Dallas County Medical Society Auxiliary and the Dallas County Medical Society.

Participating in Health Check will be students and faculty from the School of Allied Health Sciences, The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas. They will provide free medical tests and information on keeping healthy.

Services from allied health students will include biofeedback and relaxation techniques; a hypertension check with information on diet control for hypertension; an immunization schedule check for children; a display of upper limb prostheses and other orthoses and prostheses, and vocational evaluations. Also, skin-fold measurements on upper arms for obesity with information about food fads and common food fallacies, blood typing (anemia and blood glucose tests will be provided if results are abnormal) and microscope demonstrations.
