*****Psychosomatic medicine meeting includes "sleep in impotence diagnosis" and "adolescents' reaction to stress."

DALLAS--Two faculty members of The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas will participate in the program "Psychosomatic Aspects of Medicine" March 22-25 at the Fairmont Hotel here.

Dr. Howard Roffwarg, professor of psychiatry and director of the Sleep Research Cener at UTHSCD, will moderate a symposium on "Sleep Studies in the Diagnosis of Impotence." Presentations will be made by Dr. Charles Fisher, director of the Sleep Laboratory, Mount Sinai Hospital, New York City; Dr. Ismet Karacan, director of the Sleep Disorders Clinic, Baylor College of Medicine, Houston; and Dr. Paul C. Schiavi, professor of psychiatry, Mount Sinai School of Medicine, New York City. The sleep panel will be held at 8 p.m. March 23.

Dr. Kenneth Price, assistant professor of psychology at UTHSCD, will present his new findings on adolescents' response to psychological stress at 9 a.m. March 24. Dr. Price's work was done with Gary Lott, psychological assistant; Dr. David E. Fixler, associate professor of pediatrics; and Dr. Richard H. Browne, director of the Graduate Program in Mathematical Sciences. All are at the Dallas health science center.
