Dr. S. Edward Sulkin, Professor of Bacteriology and Chairman of the Department, will discuss "The Role of the Mite as a Vector in Encephalitis" with William C. Reeves (Hooper Foundation) and R. Y. Chamberlain (Communicable Disease Center) at the meeting of the American Public Health Association in New York City, New York, on November 9-12, 1953. Dr. Sulkin will also lead a panel discussion on "Diagnosis of Virus Diseases" and will be installed as Vice Chairman of the Laboratory Section of the American Public Health Association.
