DALLAS--Lawrence Weed, M.D., originator of the Problem Oriented Medical Record, will deliver the keynote address at the opening session of the 24th annual SAMA meeting Friday, March 1 at the Dallas Statler Hilton. The meeting runs through Sunday, March 3.

The meeting will focus on improving the quality of life. Workshops, talks and panel discussions will cover such subjects as aging, whole body failure, conception, nutrition, environment and prenatal care.

SAMA's house of delegates will consider approximately 30 resolutions submitted by SAMA members from medical schools throughout the country. Among the resolutions is a proposal calling for licensure of physicians according to the need for his specialty in a given state and a resolution calling for increased financing of medical education and more repayment options. The SAMA delegates will also elect national officers for 1974-75.

Medical students, house officers, private practitioners and allied health professionals have been invited to attend the SAMA meeting.
