DALLAS -- A special course on speech and language problems associated with brain disorders is being conducted this fall in a joint program between Southern Methodist University and The University of Texas (Southwestern) Medical School at Dallas.

Participants are eight graduate students in the Department of Speech Pathology and Audiology at SMU. They are enrolled in a credit course at UTSMS being taught by the faculty of the Department of Neurology. Dr. Peggy Harrison heads the program for SMU, and Miss Josephine Simonson, speech pathologist, directs the program for the medical school. Neurology Department chairman is Dr. David D. Daly.

The students observe bedside or clinic examinations of neurologic patients showing speech and/or language problems and attend lectures and seminars in the medical school environment.
