DALLAS-- Dr. David D. Daly, chairman of the Neurology Department at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School at Dallas, will leave for Russia May 10 as a member of a medical mission which will discuss neurophysiology and epilepsy with Soviet doctors.

The trip is the result of an agreement between the United States and Russia to exchange medical missions. The eight member U. S. mission, led by Dr. Richard Masland, director of the National Institute of Neurological Diseases and Blindness, will visit medical facilities in several Soviet cities.

"We hope to visit from four to six cities during the tour and exchange information with Russian neurologists," said Dr. Daly. First stop will be Moscow where the itinerary will be finalized.

The tour will be under the auspices of the Office of International Affairs, U. S. Public Health Service. The group will return June 5.
