Assembly to meet in Dallas.*

DALLAS--The 1975-76 postgraduate assembly of the Endocrine Society will be held in Dallas Oct. 6-10 at the Statler Hilton Hotel. Chairman of the group, which will be meeting for the twenty-seventh time, is Dr. C. Wayne Bardin of the Pennsylvania State College of Medicine. Dr. Jean D. Wilson, professor of internal medicine at The University of Texas Health Science Center is local chairman.

Major areas of the program and researchers chairing these sessions include the following: "Hormone Measurement and Mechanism of Action," Dr. Wilson; "Thyroid," Dr. Norman Kaplan; "Pituitary," Dr. John Porter; "Adrenal--Testis," Dr. Bardin; "Hypertension," Dr. David Kem; "Calcium and Metabolic Bone Disease," Dr. Charles Y.C. Pak; "Gonadal Function," Dr. Paul C. MacDonald; "Breast Cancer, Gonadal Function," Dr. Barry Schwarz; "Diabetes and Metabolism," Dr. Leonard L. Madison; and "Diabetes and Metabolism," Dr. Roger H. Unger.

Drs. Porter, Pak, MacDonald, Schwarz, Madison and Unger, as well as Wilson, are members of the health science center faculty at Dallas. Dr. Kaplan, a former center faculty member, is associated with the American Heart Association, which recently moved its national headquarters to Dallas. Dr. Kem is with the University of Oklahoma Health Sciences Center in Oklahoma City.

Five hundred endocrinologists are expected to attend.
