Noted hypertension expert to deliver Bromberg Lecture at UTHSCD January 19.

DALLAS--Dr. Saul Farber, noted researcher in hypertension and in renal and electrolyte metabolism, will lecture on "The Developing Role of Prostaglandins in Renal Function" at 11 a.m. January 19 at The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas.

Dr. Farber, chairman of the Department of Internal Medicine at New York University School of Medicine, will visit the campus as the Mr. and Mrs. I. G. Bromberg Visiting Professor of Medicine January 16-20. In addition to his major lecture he will meet with medical school faculty and students throughout the week.

A member of the faculty at NYU School of Medicine since 1950, Dr. Farber also serves as Director of Medicine at Bellevue Hospital and at University Hospital. He is chairman of the Liaison Committee on Continuing Medical Education and was chairman of the American Board of Internal Medicine from 1973 to 1976. Dr. Farber has served as editor of <u>The American Journal of the Medical Sciences</u> since 1971.

The Department of Internal Medicine of Southwestern Medical School, a component of UTHSCD, annually hosts an outstanding physician through the Bromberg professorship.
