PEDIATRIC UROLOGIST NAMED TO PROFESSORSHIP

DALLAS — January 30, 1995 — Dr. Terry D. Allen, professor of urology who specializes in pediatric urology at UT Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas, has been named the first holder of the Rose Mary Haggar Professorship in Urology.

Established in 1986 with a gift from the Haggar Foundation and Mrs. Rosemary Haggar Vaughan, this professorship also recognizes Dr. Paul C. Peters for his work in kidney transplantation. In December the UT System Board of Regents named Dr. Terry D. Allen first holder of the professorship .

"It is an honor and a great opportunity," said Allen. "This will give us the seed money to explore new research ideas that we could not have pursued otherwise.

"I am grateful to the Haggar family for the gift, to Dr. Peters for his efforts in establishing the professorship and to Dr. McConnell for making it available to us," Allen said. "We'll try to merit their trust in us."

Allen, who received his medical education at Baylor College of Medicine and postgraduate training at UT Southwestern, has been on the faculty since 1971. He is a nationally recognized expert in pediatric urology, specializing in pediatric voiding dysfunction. He has been president of the Urology Section of the American Academy of Pediatrics and the Society for Pediatric Urology.
