RACHOFSKY FOUNDATION DONATION FUNDS NEUROLOGICAL RESEARCH

DALLAS — October 15, 1994 — The Howard Earl Rachofsky Foundation, a frequent contributor to education and the arts, has donated \$50,000 to fund neurological research at UT Southwestern.

The donation to the medical center's Fund for Molecular Research will be matched, establishing The Howard Earl Rachofsky Foundation Fund for Research in Neurological Diseases. Scientists will use the funds to investigate the causes of neurological disorders and work toward the development of new treatments and cures.

Mr. Rachofsky had made a personal contribution of \$5,000 for the same purpose in 1993, in addition to his foundation's current gift.

The foundation is a major supporter of East Dallas Community School and St. Philip's Episcopal School, as well as the Dallas Symphony Association and the Dallas Museum of Art. The foundation's chairman, Howard E. Rachofsky, is a local businessman who serves on the boards of East Dallas Community School and the Dallas Symphony Association.
