DALLAS--The Lydia Kilborn Karcher Fund for Medical Excellence has been established at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School, Dean Charles C. Sprague announced today.

Income from the gift of approximately \$100,000 in stocks and cash by Mrs. Karcher and the Lydia K. Karcher Foundation will enable the dean to fill the most urgent needs of the medical school.

Currently, attention will be given to neurological research and personnel, including recruitment of a new chairman for the Department of Neurology.

"We are truly appreciative of this well-considered gift," commented Dr. Sprague, adding, "It represents the kind of fund for which public institutions such as ours are in greatest need."

The funds will be used for other special projects as the need arises, he said.
