DALLAS --- Dr. Halsted R. Holman, noted California scientist and medical educator, will be the Aaron Brown Visiting Lecturer at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School at Dallas Wednesday (March 12).

Dr. Holman, an authority on immunology and arthritic disease, will speak Wednesday night at a dinner at Vesuvio Ristorante, 5122 W. Lovers Lane, under auspices of Southwestern's chapter of Phi Delta Epsilon, national medical fraternity. The lectureship is sponsored by the national fraternity to bring outstanding guest speakers to Phi Delta Epsilon chapters at medical schools throughout the nation. Dr. Holman also will conduct grand rounds and confer with medical students at the school on Thursday morning (March 13). Subject of his Dallas lecture will be the philosophy of the practice of medicine and medical education.
