DALLAS--All high school students, teachers and counselors interested in learning more about medically-related vocational opportunities in today's world are invited to participate in Health Career Day at The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas February 18.

This event, to be held for the second consecutive year, is sponsored by the center, the Dallas Independent School District and the American Red Cross, Heart Association (Dallas County Chapter), Diabetes Association and Lung Association (Texas).
