DALLAS -- The American Association for Accreditation of Laboratory Animal Care has reappointed Dr. M.B. Starnes, as a consultant to its Council on Accreditation. He has served as a consultant to the Accrediting Association since its origin in 1965.

Dr. Starnes is an associate professor of microbiology and director of the Animal Resources Center at The University of Texas (Southwestern) Medical School at Dallas, and a consultant to the Veterans Administration Hospital and the St. Paul Hospital on laboratory animal medicine.
