Mengert, Professor of Obstetrics and Gynecology and Chairman of that Department in Southwestern Medical School of The University of Texas, will lead a panel discussion on "Cephalo-pelvic Disporportion" and a breakfast round table on "Chronic Cervicitis" at the meeting of the American Academy of Obstetrics and Gynecology in Cincinnati, Ohio, on December 14-16, 1953.
