president of the Southwestern
Psychological Association.*

DALLAS--Dr. Harry J. Parker, professor of rehabilitation science in the School of Allied Health Sciences, a component of The University of Texas Health Science Center at Dallas, is the new president of the Southwestern Psychological Association.

The Dallas professor was installed during the association's recent annual meeting in Houston and will serve a one-year term as head of the organization of psychologists, teachers and other practitioners in the behavioural sciences from a six-state area. He succeeds Dr. Logan Wright of the Oklahoma University Health Science Center.

Dr. Parker holds a Ph.D. degree from Northwestern University and has been associated with the School of Allied Health Sciences since its founding in 1969. He also is a professor of physical medicine & rehabilitation at the Dallas Health Science Center.
