*****Dallas HSC conducts four "satellite" meetings.

DALLAS--Three "satellite" symposia will be held on the campus of The University of Texas Health Science Center in conjunction with the 63rd annual meeting of the Federation of American Societies for Experimental Biology in early April. A fourth meeting sponsored by the Dallas Health Science Center will be held at the Fairmont Hotel.

On Thursday, April 5, a symposium titled "Protein Turnover in Heart and Skeletal Juscle" will begin at 1:30 p.m. in Gooch Auditorium. A second session begins at 9 a.m. the next morning. A symposium on "The Endocrinology of Sexual Development" will be held the evening of April 6 beginning at 7:30 p.m. in Room D1.600. The first session of the Hamster Society Satellite Symposium begins at 6 p.m. April 10 in the A.W. Harris Faculty-Alumni Center. The second session begins the next morning at 8 a.m. in Room F2.300.

A fourth satellite symposium, the "International Symposium on Fever," will be held in the Parisian Room of the Fairmont Hotel on April 11 and 12. Co-sponsored by the Health Science Center and McNeil Laboratories, the symposium has been organized by Dr. James Lipton, associate professor of physiology and neurology.
