DALLAS--Mrs. Linda Bumgarner, graduate student in micro-biology at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School at Dallas, has received one of two \$3,500 Waksman Fellowships awarded nationally by the American Society for Microbiology Foundation.

The award for the coming academic year will support Mrs. Bumgarner's research studies into the disease mechanism and immune responses involved in gonorrhea. The research is part of her work toward a doctoral degree at Southwestern.

The prestigious fellowship is named for Dr. Selman A. Waksman, Nobel Prize-winning director emeritus of the Institute of Microbiology at Rutgers University.
