SHERMAN--An arthritis symposium for physicians in the North Texas area will be held here June 17. Titled "Current Concepts in Arthritis," the program is designed to present the latest information on the diagnosis and management of common arthritis problems.

There is no registration fee for the program, which will be held at Medical Plaza Hospital with registration beginning at 8 a.m. A public forum will be held from 2-4 p.m. at the Texoma Medical Center Auditorium in Denison. All persons interested in arthritis are invited to attend the public forum and question the specialists.

The symposium is sponsored by the Rheumatic Diseases Unit of The University of Texas Southwestern Medical School at Dallas, the A. Webb Roberts Center for Continuing Education in Dallas and the North Texas Chapter of the Arthritis Foundation.
